For the last 7 months our team have been consistently running a Worship and Prayer Service in the border city of Maesot. There is a great need of encouragement and support for both the local leaders and foreign missionaries working there. The border is in constant state of crisis but we believe as we fight in the spiritual realm we will see breakthrough in the natural.

## Haven of Grace

We have been sheltering 9 mums and their children over the last 10 months. 3 transitioned from the home at the end of last year and 4 others will have transitioned out from our program by 31<sup>st</sup> March. They have each graduated from our vocational school and are now able to find jobs or start their own small businesses. Most of all they have Jesus in their hearts. We will continue to followup and support their rent or food for the next 3-6 months to make sure they are well settled.

Recently the Lord has opened the door requested by our local council leaders for us to reach into our local community. Every fortnight, Lin our Social Worker leads a team to visit the poorest and most vulnerable in our local community to share the love of Christ.



## Sozolife Interns

This last quarter we have received and been training up 8 New Interns. Some will be staying on for the year while others have come during the long summer break here in Thailand to learn skills and learn about walking with God.

Ci is being sponsored to go to a school for evangelism for the next 2 months.



We want to officially announce that at the end of February we successfully purchased the block of land next door to Sozolife for our Farm Project. Thank you! For those of you who do not know this block of land was originally a cannabis farm! We prayed for the Lord to remove it and in the end the Lord has given it into our hands for his Kingdom purposes. A miracle!

For each one who gave towards this project thank you for sowing into something that will help us be a blessing not only to our own ministry but to many others for years to come.

Long and the farm team have already begun work to move and expand the projects we already had running on the Sozolife base. We have 1000 baby fish in our new pond, 60 hens and preparing to purchase another 40 this month. Clearing the land ready for planting vegetables. One whole green house will be dedicated to helping villages rebuild along the Thai Burma border.

## Sozolife Kindergarten

Kru Kem and the teachers have done an incredible job over the last 6 months running our Kindergarten program.

In May, we will be official opening to the community. We have capacity to take 36 students total, providing a quality early learning environment for children aged 9 month to 5 years old.

## Current Financial Needs:

- AID for border villagers fleeing the onslaught of attacks and bombing from the Burmese Junta. To help 1000 families (\$25,000 AUD)
- Support for Naw Lah's surgery in June (\$2,500 AUD)
- Staff Pay for the next 3 months (\$15,000 AUD)
- Haven Home No. 2 to house up to 7 women and their children. (\$20,000 AUD)
- Haven kids school fees and supplies for 10 kids for 2025. (\$3,000 AUD)
- Sponsorship for 5 mums starting in May (\$300 per month for 12 months)
