Sozolife Kids Camp!

In the first week of May we held our annual summer kids camp at Sozolife. Our theme was “Grow in God” and we used the illustration of a tree from its roots to its fruits to illustrate how God works in our lives. The camp went for 5 days and on the last evening session we had a powerful time of testimonies and worship where many of the kids were touched by God.



72 kids from our local community attended our annual kids camp!

This camp is one of the ways we want to reach our local community and younger generation with the Gospel. Most of the kids that came were from non-believing families. We have started a Youth Connect group once a month to followup and build relationship. Most of the youth are preteens aged 8-14 and from the local schools around where Sozolife is located.

Sozolife Farm



The farm is steadily developing and especially during this rainy season we are quickly seeing fruit from the veggies and trees being planted. So far we have over 1000 fish in the pond, will be adding another 100 chickens and hatching our own quail. We have planted banana trees, papaya trees, chili and long beans and corn. We have an abundance of mangoes and limes and lemons and even found a cherry tree! We will be restarting our piggery in the coming months. We have also been able to give away 30 hens to one of the schools on the border we support to help them start their own egg farm.

Community Outreach

This month we have been able to reach out and regularly visit 19 individuals in our local community. Many of these are elderly folk who have no family near them and are often left alone for days with no assistance. Our team has gone to spend time in conversation, give essential items and food and do house clean ups.

For one particular lady we were able to spend time with her over 2 months during her final days. She just passed away last week from breast cancer. She came to know the Lord in her final months and we were able to encourage her in the Word and with praise and worship. Sozolife was able to help cover the costs of the funeral.



Sozolife Construction

With heavy rain this monsoon season we have taken time to make urgent repairs on some of the roofs and ceilings around the base. We have been able to add mesh doors to each of the Haven Rooms to keep mosquitoes out and have enclosed the kitchen to prevent the water and dust coming in.



We are amazed at the incredible response we have had to the appeals we have made for aid over the last few months. Thousands of families have been assisted through your generosity. In our recent outreaches these past 2 weeks we were able to provide food and essential supplies to 8 different groups of people. Two major areas were schools with 250-300 children each school. A community of refugees with over 75 families taking shelter due to the crisis in Myanmar. 2 smaller schools set up in the jungles along the riverbanks of the Thai Myanmar border and families scattered along the river taking shelter from drones and jets that have been bombing their villages.

Myanmar continues to go through nationwide turmoil with great challenges caused by the cruelty of the military dictatorship and also by ongoing natural disasters. In the last 3 months the country has faced severe and ongoing earthquake tremors, fires and flooding along with the bombing and persecution from the military junta. The people are tired and worn out and continue to be oppressed by their own leaders. Thousands of young people have fled to neighboring countries to escape enforced conscription both young men and women.

The needs are great and seem to be endless. That is why it is also strongly on our hearts to minister to those who are on the ground living in Maesot the many missionaries and local pastors and ministries that are giving and helping people day in and day out. Every month we host a worship service to bring refreshing, encouragement and reminding people that the battle is still the Lord's

To see the vision of this Kindergarten come to life is such a blessing! We have 16 students with 6 coming from families in our neighborhood. Parents have expressed the difference they have seen already in their little ones and their development in speech and motor skills and how happy the kids are to go to school.

We desire this kindergarten to be an outreach into our local community and also to make an impact as we be an example of valuing the early learning and development of children and provide the space where children and learn and develop through play and creative learning, providing a genuinely loving and caring environment ensuring their safety.

We currently have 5 teachers and accommodate 4 children with special needs. We hope that this Kindergarten can also be able to pick up developmental delays early on to help provide children with the support they need from as early as possible.
